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Dear Patient,

Effectively preparing for weight loss surgery will reduce stress, save money, minimize your risk of complications, increase the amount of weight you will lose and make you much more likely to keep the weight off over the long term.

Below is a list of steps our patients must go through when undergoing bariatric surgery with **Dr. Prokurat.** Some steps may vary slightly, depending on insurance requirements and each patient's individual medical needs:

- Contact your insurance company to verify
 whether you have Bariatric Surgery benefits and
 Nutritional Counseling. Nutrition clearance is
 required to have surgery. If so, what criteria you
 must meet in order to have bariatric surgery preauthorized. For the most current information about
 how to ensure your surgery is approved, it is critical
 that you contact your insurer as only they can
 provide you with the most up-to-date information.
- Start working with **Dr. Prokurat's team** from insurance and financing considerations to required pre-op testing to pre-op instructions specific to your situation, there are a variety of issues your surgeon will help you address while preparing for weight loss surgery.
- Schedule your initial consultation with Dr.
 Prokurat, complete the online registration form and find out what paperwork and medical history you'll need to move forward (e.g. Letter of Medical Necessity and Letter of Medical Clearance, medical records etc.). All of your questions regarding bariatric surgery and our process will be answered in person at the new patient appointment.
- If your insurance company requires a referral to see a specialist, please obtain a referral from your primary medical doctor and bring it with you on the day of your appointment.

- Attend Dr. Prokurat Support Groups to learn more about your options, to get a better handle on what to expect and to learn how to best work with our team.
- Schedule pre-surgery tests and consultations/ physicals to confirm that you are a good candidate for surgery. Arrange and begin your physiciansupervised diet program (if required by your insurance company or surgeon).
- After evaluating all tests and completing all paperwork and requirements, our office will confirm that you are clear to proceed with surgery and will obtain pre-authorization from your insurance company (if applicable).
